COMMINGLED-Commingled products as described below may be mixed together and must be placed in the blue Township Recycling containers or 25-gallon garbage containers without lids. No plastic bags.

Glass containers-

All glass containers- food and beverage jars. Rinse with warm water then toss. Remove lids from cans and bottles and discard them in the trash.

Aluminum-

Soda cans and clean foil.

Plastics-PETE #1, HDPE #2 through #7

Milk jugs, water bottles, detergent, yogurt tubs, cottage cheese, margarine tubs, as well as plastic lids. No styrofoam or plastic bags

Steel & Tin Cans-

Small scrap metals-household items only and bi-metal cans

NEWSPAPER-All PAPER PRODUCTS, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER, MIXED PAPER, Magazines, etc. Combine all paper products in a blue Township Recycling containers or 25-gallon containers without lids. Do not put any papers in plastic or paper bags.

Newspapers including Inserts, Coupons, & Advertisements

Mixed Paper and Magazines-

Includes magazines, catalogs, soft cover books, color inserts, envelopes (with or without cellophane windows, junk mail, sweepstakes forms, office paper (fax, photocopy, computer,

White ledger and envelope paper), non-metallic wrapping paper, real estate books, NCR and shredded Paper.

Corrugated Cardboard-

The type used to make cardboard boxes cartons and similar corrugated material, but not wax-coated or poly coated boxes. Cardboard boxes must be broken down, string tied or placed in another box.
